

# Journal of Joseph Hyrum Ogden - July 1947

July 1947 August 1

Mon 28 - Mother and I picked, husked, and processed 11 pt. of corn, and took it to the locker, took Ella some corn + vegetables, did some shopping. Was a very hot day I irrigated lawn. Dan + Joyce, Ray + Margie called, got some vegetables out of the garden. I did part of my Ward teaching. Fern cut the front lawn.

Tues 29 - I took a box full of ears of corn up to Roy's. Helped him haul 3 loads of hay. I got 7 qt. milk, 1 doz. 10 eggs and 2 fried. Mother put out a big wash, and bottled 7 quart of carrots, Fern helped.

Wed 30 - Dan brought Brenda here, at 3 A.M. and took Joyce to the hospital, her baby boy was born about 1<sup>st</sup> P.M. Mother cleaned up house, washed and waxed floors, Fern did the ironing. Rachel went to Fillmore at site. Another very hot day. South Wind.

Thurs 31 - I irrigated garden and flowers, such extreme heat, you have to keep watering. Mother and the girls did up work, Mother made a cover for the safe and did some mending, + helped take care of Brenda. I finished ward teaching tonight, Mother went to the hospital to see Joyce, with Dannie, took some flowers and 2 of Betty's bed jackets for her. A very warm day. Dan took Brenda home tonight.

August

Fri 1 - Mother and I went to town, got my pants from the cleaners, sat in the park in the shade for awhile, then we drove out to Carlson's in Riverdale to get him to make some hinges to put on the Cemetery gate.
